Informal crossing point between bus stops outside the pub. There is a natural crossing point between these two bus stops as the pavement runs out on both sides of the road. Pedestrians are forced to cross due to pavements ceasing so improving safety would seem sensible and would allow the provision of a drop kerb for wheelchair and buggy access.
